Chicago voters can access sample ballots for the upcoming March 19, 2024 Presidential Primary Election and all of their voter information on the Your Voter Information webpage at chicagoelections.gov.

There, voters can verify their voter registration status ahead of the election, see and print their sample ballot, view the locations of their nearest Early Voting sites, locate their precinct polling place for Election Day, and check on the status of their Vote By Mail application.

The Political Party ballots available in Chicago for the March 19th Primary Election are:

- Democratic
- Republican
- Libertarian (Wards 1, 5, 36, and 38 only)
- Non-Partisan (includes only referenda questions)

<u>Early Voting</u> in Downtown Chicago starts on Thursday, February 15 at 9:00am at the Board Supersite, 191 N. Clark, and at the Board Offices, 69 W. Washington - 6th Floor. Both locations are ADA-compliant and fully accessible to voters with disabilities and contain secured Drop Boxes for voters to return their Vote By Mail ballot.

Early Voting in all 50 Wards of Chicago will begin Monday, March 4, 2024 at 9:00am.

<u>Vote By Mail</u> ballots have begun to ship to voters who have successfully completed their application and to Permanent Roster voters. The deadline to apply to Vote By Mail is Thursday, March 14 by 5:00pm.
